The basics

- Financial planning is **essential**
- Explore all possibilities before starting the course
- Speak to a Student Adviser at the University when you are at the planning stage
- It's not necessarily as bad as the things you've heard in the news...

Degrees (BA) and Foundation Degrees (FdA)

- Apply to Student Finance England (SFE)
- www.gov.uk/apply-online-for-student-finance
- Loans, Grants, Tuition fees
- One application – online
- **Apply early** – from February 2021
- Don't have to wait for a confirmed offer

Timing



Tuition Fees

- Tuition fees are £9,250 in 2021/22 at UAL
- You can get a **tuition fee loan** for the full amount
- All 'Home' students are eligible
- Not dependant on family income
- You will not have to pay fees before or during your studies

Living costs

- Maintenance **Loan**
 - Depends on your who you live with and
 - Your household income
 - Between £3,516 and £12,382 (if not living with parents)
- Additional grants are available if you have a disability, are a lone parent, etc.
- Bursaries and Grants are available from the University once you have started the course

Further Education

FE courses

- Foundation Diploma in A&D
 - Camberwell
 - Central Saint Martins
- 1 year preparation for Degree courses
- Funded differently

Funding for FE courses

- Tuition fees
 - **Free** if under 19 on 31 August 2021, or
 - £5,420* if 19 or over on 31 August 2021
 - Advanced Learner Loan available
 - Covers the whole fee

FE courses

- Bursaries available from Learner Support Funds
- Apply to UAL in July 2021
 - Residential Bursary
 - Vulnerable Young Person Bursary
 - Hardship
 - Julian Hippisley
 - Free School Meals
- Help for you parents – Child Benefit and Child Tax Credit continues if Under 19

EU Nationals

- Apply for the **EU Settlement Scheme** now if you and your family haven't done so
- Gain 'pre-settled' or 'settled' status
- This difference between being a Home or an International fee payer in 21/22
- Closes 31 December 2020
